Design and Technology Unit - The Great British Menu

Dear Parent/Guardian,

For their Autumn 1 topic, the Upper Juniors will be learning all about healthy foods and where they come from. The children will be researching the history of the Cornish Pasty and eventually designing and baking their own pasty with a filling of their choice. Over the course of the half term, children will learn to make a starter salad with dressing, a main course pasty and a fruit trifle style dessert.



To help with this exciting project, each child will need to bring in the following equipment if they have it, which must be clearly labelled for a prompt return. If you would like to provide a £1 voluntary donation towards food costs, it would be very much appreciated!

Deerleap only: Wednesday 18th September

Wilverley & Hawkhill only: Thursday 19th September

Equipment required:

- A chopping board
- An apron
- A vegetable peeler
- A grater
- A small knife suitable for chopping vegetables (not a butter knife)

Wilverley & Deerleap only: Monday 23rd September

Hawkhill only: Tuesday 24th September

Equipment required:

- A plastic mixing bowl
- A small chopping board (no glass)
- An apron
- A rolling pin
- A vegetable peeler
- A grater
- A small knife suitable for chopping vegetables (not a butter knife)

All equipment will need to be in a named bag and handed <u>by an adult</u> to the members of UJ staff on the gate. Any sharp items should be sealed in a tupperware container. They will then need to be collected <u>by an adult</u> from the office/class teacher at the end of the day to be cleaned.

Please note: children are not allowed to carry any sharp equipment onto the school grounds.

Please do not worry if you do not have all of the items on the list at home. We do not expect parents/guardians to buy equipment and we have a small supply of spares in school.
