REMINDER FOR PARENTS CLAIMING FUNDING FOR WORKING FAMILIES IN THE SPRING TERM 2025

All parents who are working, are entitled to funding for working families and want to claim funded extended hours for 3 and 4 year olds (30 hours childcare) or funded expanded hours for 9 month and 2 year olds (15 hours childcare), must make sure they have applied to HMRC no later than 31 December 2024.

All parents with a unique funding code need to make sure their details are up to date.

They must do this every three months via the **WEBSITE**. We recommend applying in plenty of time as this process can take some time, particularly if you are self-employed.
