	you will provide your own packed lunch.
Medical Declaration	Please inform the office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to
	your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication.
	If your child has an inhaler in school, please ensure it is in
	school on the day and it is in date.
Consent	The blanket trip consent covers this trip and therefore, you will need to let the
	school know IN WRITING that your child will not be attending by Friday
	28th February.
