Talking Topic

We are delighted to announce that our first two week topic will be **'Delightful Donaldson'**. During this topic, we will be reading all the Julia Donaldson stories (many of which we are sure your child is already familiar with). The children will be learning about their new classes and the daily routines. They will spend lots of time getting to make new friends with their peers and buddies. They will talk about feelings and rules, where the children will learn to work as a team and ensure that everyone is happy at school. The whole topic will culminate in a **Gruffalo Party**, "Exit Point" **(which will also include a SPLAT Stay Play and Learn All Together)**.
