#### **When will I be able to view my child's online report/assessment information?**

## THREADWORM

We have had reports of children having threadworm. If your child has threadworm, please start treatment as soon as possible. They are, however, able to continue to attend school. A pharmacist will be able to advise you on the most appropriate treatment for your family, or you may wish to discuss this with your GP.

You will need to take additional hygiene measures at home to prevent it spreading and to reduce the chance of reinfection and [NHS Choices](#) offers useful information about threadworm.

The school always places a high importance on general hygiene through effective handwashing but we ask that you please notify the office so that we can take any additional measures which might be appropriate.

## YEAR 5/6 EXIT POINT
