Thank you for your understanding and cooperation this week in relation to the disruption on Hordle Lane and Vicarage Lane.

We have been advised by BTU that further survey work is now required the week commencing **22nd January for up to 5 days** which will affect Sky End Lane.

For this week Sky End Lane will be closed on the junction with Everton Road between 9.30am—3.30pm each day. Access will be maintained to Sky End Lane and Longfield Road from Vicarage Lane.

We have been advised by BTU that they may complete the work within 3 days if everything runs smoothly and have apologised for any inconvenience caused by the work.

Following conversations with Drew Smith Group, we are hopeful that the work on Hordle Lane will be completed by this time, but if not there may be some further problems. Please be mindful of this over the next 2 weeks.
