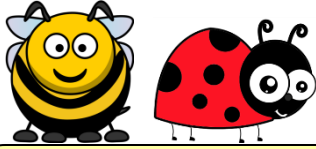

Talking Topic

Over the next few weeks we will be exploring the topic '**Food**', within this topic we will be :
