COLOURS

What are 'Colours'?

At Hordle, we have many different ways of celebrating all the wonderful things that the children achieve both within and outside of school. One of the latest to be added to the broad spectrum of celebrations, is the 'Colours' Award.

What is the purpose of the 'Colours' Award?

These are used to recognise academic excellence in a particular curriculum subject and to celebrate demonstration of one of the Hordle Learning Superhero values.

How do children earn their 'Colours'?

Children can earn their 'Colours' in two ways. The first is by showing excellence in their learning for a particular subject. This might be because they have a particular talent (such as being an amazing artist and producing life-like sketches in Art) or they can be awarded to children who have shown incredible improvements in a particular subject. Secondly, children can earn this prestigious award for demonstrating that they can apply one of the seven Hordle Learning Superheroes, for example they have shown great resilience in their learning. Any member of staff can nominate a child from across the school to receive their 'Colours' Award.

How often are 'Colours' Award assemblies?

We hold very special 'Colours' Award assemblies once a term. These assemblies are like Hordle's version of the Oscars. They involve glitzy comperes, posh frocks, lots of glitter, twinkling lights and smiling. Each assembly starts with members of staff being presented with glittery envelopes and reading out who has achieved each Colour and ends with lots of cheering, clapping and smiling. They really are a sight to behold.

What do children do with their 'Colours' Award?

Just like our HSA awards, these are worn on the arm of their school: jumper, cardigan or hoodie. Please note the 'Colours' Awards are sewn on to the opposite arm to the sporting achievements.

What subjects/superheroes are 'Colours' awarded in/for?

Children can achieve their 'Colours' in any subject from across the curriculum. These include: Geography, History, Debating, Spelling, Times tables, Writing, Mathematics, Art, RE, Music, DT, Languages, Drama, Computing, Reading, Philosophy etc. They can also achieve a 'Colour' for any of the seven Superhero Learning Values; these include: resilience, risk taking, responsibility, motivation, sense of humour, eco and teamship.
