As a few of our children are currently having building work completed at home and others have shown interest in this, we have decided that we will spend a week exploring the topic "Builders and Construction". The children will get to build a wall using foam bricks and wet sand and explore measuring different items using a variety of measuring equipment. They will also be set a challenge of building the tallest tower using plastic cups, straws and shaving foam. Along with these exciting activities the children will be able to role play being builders using the tools, tool bench and cardboard boxes.

We would love the children to be involved in collecting some objects to be used for a variety of purposes in our outdoor learning environment. Should you be able to collect any of the following it would be much appreciated:
