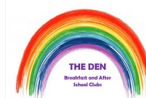

## IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM SCOPAY ONLINE PAYMENTS

As of **30<sup>th</sup> April 2018**, any users of **Windows XP or Windows Vista** can no longer make payments via SCOPAY Online Payments System, which are processed by WorldPay.

Unfortunately, users of these operating systems may have to upgrade their system to be able to make online payments from the now on.

From the **30th June 2018**, ALL websites that accept card payments will no longer allow users of Windows XP and Windows Vista to use their websites. WorldPay are implementing this change on **30th April 2018**.

While you will be able to access SCOPAY, view the content and perform tasks in the normal way, you will receive an error message and payments will fail to process if you attempt to pay online.

This change is being enforced by the PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard) and is outside the School's control and we apologise for inconvenience that this may cause.
