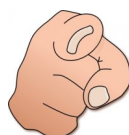

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TERM TIME ABSENCE

Thinking of taking a holiday in term time? Parents are strongly advised by the Government and Local Authority to avoid taking children out of school in term time because of the disruption it causes to their education.

If your child has unauthorised absences for 10 sessions (1 day is 2 sessions) or more in a 100 session period, you will be liable to a fixed penalty notice and a fine.

E-SAFETY ROBLOX

Roblox is a very popular app played by primary school aged children. We just wanted to remind you of these concerns:

Children can receive messages from people that they do not know through the game - it is recommended that you check your child's in game message box

Children can talk to other users they do not know using a headset - it is recommended that you check your child's account and look to see if they have friends you do not recognise (Each account can have up to 200 friends).

Children can see other characters that are not wearing clothes and/or do inappropriate things - we recommend that parents always supervise their children when using a device.



ZIP IT

Keep your personal stuff private and think about what you say and do online.



BLOCK IT

Block people who send nasty messages and don't open unknown links and attachments.



FLAG IT

Flag up with someone you trust if anything upsets you or if someone asks to meet you offline.

HEADLICE

If you find headlice in your child's hair it is essential that you treat your child properly and let the school office know. When we get a notification of a child with headlice, the school will inform other parents of the class affected (no names will be disclosed) so they can check their child's hair.

We ask that EVERYONE undertakes regular weekly (and where appropriate daily) checks to ensure that your child/family is not affected.

- Children who have hair that is long enough to be tied in a pony tail, should do so every day—even on Mufti days.
