IMPORTANT INFORMATION TRAINERS

It has come to my attention that some families are not complying with the spirit of our uniform code of conduct for trainers. A huge number of very bright colours are creeping in and there is less and less adherence to the 'predominantly black' rule.

As we approach the end of term and the summer holidays when I know many of you will be buying new shoes for the next academic year, I would like to give you all fair warning that we will be much stricter on this next term and will now insist on trainers that are **BLACK WITH VERY SMALL AMOUNTS OF WHITE OR GREY ONLY.**

Black and white trainers are thankfully very trendy at the moment so there are a wide number of choices available at a range of reasonable prices.

I remind all families that boys do not need to wear trainers at all as their normal school shoes are sufficiently sturdy to tolerate the daily mile.

Equally girls also do not HAVE to wear trainers provided that as a parent you are happy that your daughter's school shoes have very sturdy soles and provide excellent lateral support – please discuss this with your shoe provider. Absolutely no slip on shoes or ballet style pumps as part of the school uniform.

Thank you for ensuring that you follow the spirit of our uniform code as you would for any other aspect of our school uniform.

Free School Meals

Are you entitled?

There have been changes to the criteria for eligibility for Free School Meals. You may be eligible if you or your partner receive:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

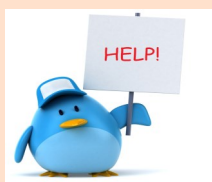
If your child is eligible for and getting free school meals at any time before 31 March 2022, they'll remain eligible until this date.

There are so many benefits—not just a free meal:

- Free after school clubs
- Free membership to the Children's University
- Free school sweater/cardigan annually
- Free P.E Kit Top
- Subsidised music tuition

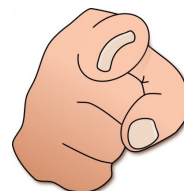
