HSA PASSPORT POINTS

We are fast approaching the end of term and our final HSA assembly of the year where we will award children with their HSA colours (Bronze, Silver or Gold), depending on how many points they have on their HSA Passport. The HSA team need to be made aware if the following applies to you:

- Your child does not take part in a school sports club, but does one out of school.
- Your child has taken part in a tournament or event outside of school but has not taken part in one in school.
- Your child has reached DISTRICT/COUNTY level in any event outside of school

Points for all school sports clubs and events are automatically calculated so we **do not** need to know about these.

If these criteria apply to your child please complete the online form below. The deadline for this is **Friday 13th July** and unfortunately, anything added after this date will mean we are unable to celebrate your child's colours until the next HSA assembly in the Autumn.

- Children no longer have straws on their tuck drinks.



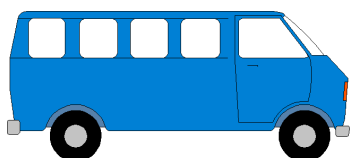
CALLING ALL MINI BUS DRIVERS
