Where can I buy the new uniform?

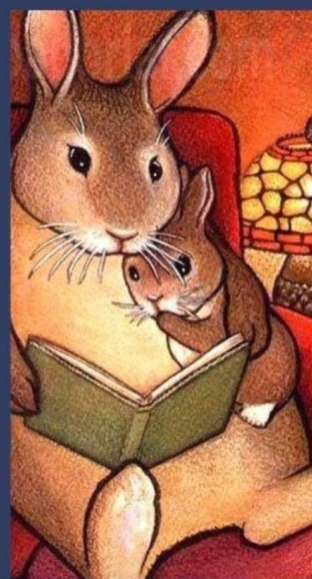
