We would like the people of Lymington to join in our commemoration by contributing a homemade Poppy. It could be made from tissue, felt, wool or paper, it could be drawn, crochet, knitted, cut out... whatever you feel like doing. We'd like this to be a real special community project with locals of all ages joining in to remember not just those who fought, but what they fought for.

People can drop their Poppy contribution to the museum any day between 10am-5pm by 1 November please. Do come along to see our Remembrance Day window which will be displayed between 2 - 11 November.
