REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

Sunday 11th November

To mark the hundred year anniversary of the end of the First World War, a special event is being organised by the Parish Council at the War Memorial on Everton Road. The Memorial holds names of people from the three Parish villages (Tiptoe, Hordle and Everton) who died in both World wars.

This year, the Parish Council have arranged for a road closure and a procession along Everton Road from Woodcock Lane to the War Memorial. The procession will start at 10.30am and will be followed by a service, silence and wreath laying at 10.45am at the War Memorial. There will also be a service at All Saints Church Hordle at 9.30am that morning for those who wish to attend.

From Monday of next week our school council members will be selling poppies when the school gates open each morning. There will also be an opportunity for children to buy a poppy when the council members visit their classroom.
