Year 5 residential visit – Little Canada

Thank you for responding to our recent consultation regarding the year 5 residential trip in 2019. Based on the feedback we have received, we are very excited to be able to announce that a four day residential visit to [Little Canada](#), a PGL centre on the Isle of Wight, has been booked for **Friday 29th March- Monday 1st April 2019**. Please note this is a change from previous years and has been booked due to an overwhelming majority of people showing favour to the weekend trip. The trip will follow the same procedures as previous years and more details will be shared in a meeting later in the year. The trip will be a weekend trip following on from a normal 4 day week in school. Therefore it has been decided that parents/guardians will be able to choose whether to send their children to school on Tuesday 2nd April. This trip will be for Year 5 pupils only.

The trip is a once in a lifetime opportunity, giving pupils the chance to live with their peers, develop independence and take greater responsibility. More importantly, they will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of exhilarating activities that provide challenge and adventure in a safe situation. In the past, pupils have experienced adventurous activities such as kayaking, abseiling, quad biking, the trapeze, giant swing and many more.

The children will be under the guidance of fully qualified instructors all week who will ensure that all children have a memorable experience. Pupils will be accompanied by at least one member of the teaching staff, another member of staff and very supportive parents of the school. A meeting with more details of the trip will be held in the Autumn term which will give parents and children a chance to hear more about the trip and ask any questions.

School visits are always a fantastic time for both children and adults alike and it is wonderful to see the children grow in self-confidence and rise to personal challenges in a non-academic environment. We are very much looking forward to taking all of the Year 5 pupils on this exciting residential visit.

The total cost of the PGL residential will be **£151.44**. To reserve your child's place, we request that a non-refundable deposit of **£30** be made online via [Scopay](#) and that you complete this [online form](#) by 18th May 2018.
