Lepe Beach Study

As part of our Beach topic next half term, the Upper Juniors will have the exciting opportunity to visit a beach and study coastal features. Where?	Lepe Country Park and Education Centre, Hampshire
When?	Wednesday 13 th March 2019 Thursday 14 th March 2019 (See above for when your child is going).
Why?	To learn more about geographical features of beaches
Transport information	Children will travel by coach. Departing at 9.00am and arriving back at school by 3.15pm for normal end of day procedures.
Payment	£11.43 - The cost of this trip is the cost to the school and no profit is made. This payment is for coach hire and two outdoor park ranger-led workshops at Lepe Study Centre.
How to pay	We request that payment for this trip be made online via internet payments by Friday 8th February.
Clothing	Children are to wear school uniform, wellington boots or walking boots and a waterproof jacket and have with them a small named rucksack. (If the weather forecast indicates wet weather, waterproof trousers are essential as the majority of this day will be outside.)

Lunch	Please provide your child with a water bottle and a packed lunch in a named plastic bag which can be disposed of.
If you do not want your child to attend	The 'Blanket Trip Consent' covers this trip and therefore, you will need to let the school know IN WRITING that your child will NOT be attending by Friday 8th February .
Medical Declaration	Please inform the School Office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication.
