Marwell Zoo

As part of our Africa topic, next half term, Key Stage 1 will have the chance to visit Marwell Zoo. This will be a great opportunity for the children to further their learning about African animals and habitats. They will also attend a hands-on workshop run by the Marwell Education Team.

Who?	Key Stage 1
Where?	Marwell Zoo, Hampshire
When?	Thursday 21 st March 2019
Why?	To further learn about African animals and their habitats
Transport information	Children will travel by coach. Departing at 9.00am and arriving back at school by 4.30pm where children will be dismissed from their classrooms.
Payment	£13.53 - The cost of this trip is the cost to the school and no profit is made. This payment is for coach hire and a workshop.
How to pay	We request that payment for this trip be made online via internet payments by Friday 22nd February.
Clothing	Children are to wear school uniform and a waterproof coat. They will also need to bring a small named rucksack to carry their packed lunch and water bottle. <u>If on the day, the weather is particularly sunny and hot please apply sun cream before they arrive in school and send them with a sun hat.</u>
Parent Helpers	We would be grateful of parent helpers. In order to allow the children to move around the zoo in small groups, we do need quite a few parent helpers. Lunch	Your child will require a packed lunch. KS1 children are all entitled to a free school meal under a government scheme and this includes a packed lunch for school trips. Please complete the slip attached by Friday 1st March to indicate what lunch you would like your child to have on the trip. Please make sure you provide your child with a named plastic bag (which can be disposed of) and their school water bottle.
If you do not want your child to attend	The 'Blanket Trip Consent' covers this trip and therefore, you will need to let the school know IN WRITING that your child will NOT be attending by Friday 1st March.
Medical Declaration	Please inform the School Office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication.

We are all looking forward to this trip and know that it will really help to enrich the children's learning opportunities during our Africa topic.
