WORLD BOOK DAY

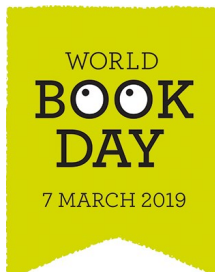
Friday 8th March
