IMPORTANT CHANGES TO BOOKINGS AT THE DEN BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS



Bookings for Summer term will shortly be available for The Den Breakfast and After School Clubs. Please note that there are some important changes which will affect all YR-Y6 pupils using this service.

Why are we changing the process?

Due to the ongoing popularity of both clubs, we are introducing a booking facility for The Den via your child's Scopay account, allowing you to book your own sessions at either club **up to the day before**. For on the day bookings, please continue to call the school or email theden@hordleprimary.co.uk.

This will go live from Tuesday 2nd April and you will be able to book sessions from 23rd April to 19th July inclusive. Booking and payments will not be available on Scopay until 2nd April.

This additional function will allow you to book ad-hoc and regular bookings, whilst keeping track of outstanding balances, with the ability to check statements, payments and dates booked. Please follow the below instructions:

- Login to Scopay and click on the *View Products* page
- Find Breakfast Club or After School Club and click *Order Sessions* against the relevant club
- Use the calendar and click the required dates
- Click the appropriate session choice for the date and click OK. Please ensure you select the correct session dependant upon your child's age (particularly relevant to YR children)
- If you enter an incorrect date or session, simply click again and click the new session choice (e.g. None) and click OK.
- You will now see the total amount due in account balances

Please note that whilst we are able to offer flexibility with last minute bookings, both clubs are becoming increasingly popular and therefore we have introduced a maximum number of spaces available each day. As a result, we may not be able to guarantee a space should you book sessions last minute.

Payment for sessions

Please pay for sessions **in advance** via your child's Scopay account, as you do for dinners and trips etc. Accounts will not be allowed to build up debt so please take this into account and plan payments accordingly. Payments made via childcare vouchers will remain the same.
