**New Forest Wildlife Park**

As part of our Wild Animals topic, next term, Ladybirds and Bumblebees will have the chance to visit the New Forest Wildlife Park. This will be a great opportunity for the children to further their learning about animals and their habitats. This will be a fully guided tour and the children will get to experience some of the animals during feeding times.

<b>Who?</b>	Foundation
<b>Where?</b>	New Forest Wildlife Park
<b>When?</b>	Tuesday 30th April 2019
<b>Why?</b>	To further learn about wild animals and their habitats
<b>Transport information</b>	Children will travel by coach. <b>Departing at 9.00am and arriving back at school by 3.15pm. Children will be dismissed, as normal, at the end of the day.</b>
<b>Payment and how to pay</b>	£14.61 - The cost of this trip is the cost to the school and no profit is made. This payment is for coach hire, entrance to the centre and fully guided tours. <b>We request that payment for this trip be made online via internet payments by 5th April.</b>
<b>Clothing</b>	Children are to wear school uniform and a waterproof coat. They will also need to bring a small named rucksack to carry their packed lunch and water bottle. <u>If, on the day, the weather is particularly sunny and hot please apply sunscreen before they arrive in school and send them with a sun hat.</u>
<b>Parent Helpers</b>	<b>We would be grateful of parent helpers.</b> In order to allow the children to move around the wildlife park in small groups, we do need a few parent helpers. <b>Lunch</b>	Your child will require a packed lunch. Foundation children are all entitled to a free school meal under a government scheme and this includes a packed lunch for school trips.  <b>Please complete the slip attached by 5th April to indicate what lunch you would like your child to have on the trip.</b>  <b>Please make sure you provide your child with a named plastic bag (which can be disposed of) and their school water bottle.</b>
<b>If you do not want your child to attend</b>	The 'Blanket Trip Consent' covers this trip and therefore, you will need to let the school know <b>IN WRITING</b> that your child will NOT be attending by 5th April.
<b>Medical Declaration</b>	Please inform the School Office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication.

We are all looking forward to this trip and know that it will really help to enrich the children's learning opportunities during our Wild Animals topic.
