How to make bookings

Please log on to your child's Scopay account, choose the Hub Club you wish to book and then **tick the consent box before** selecting the *Pay in full* option. The consent box will open to enable you to enter pick up information so please do this before you attempt to check out and make payment as you will be unable to proceed until this is completed.

Bookings will be open from Tuesday 2nd April until Friday 26th April, after which time the system will be closed.
