Continued membership with the New Forest School Sports Partnership	Gaining the school access to a range of competitions in different sports and festivals. Additionally, access to a whole school festival, girls football training and cricket sessions. Giving teachers the opportunity to develop their CPD in a variety of courses including dance and gymnastics. Supporting the PE coordinator in any developments within the subject through meetings and regular contact with the School Games organiser.	£1895	The main focus of the Excellence Plan for Sport and PE this year is inclusion and the sport premium funding is being used to enable us to achieve the very high ambitions we set ourselves. 1 - To increase the number of children who have the opportunity to take part in an out of school competition or festival. Competitions and festivals are now taking place in person with some virtual competitions continuing also. So far this year nearly 100 children have participated in a competition or festival. 2 - To improve class level competitive sport opportunities Sports leaders are using their skills and having an impact on PE across the school. We will evaluate the impact at the end of the year. 3 - Developed a tiered approach to school Sports Ambassadorship - we are continuing to develop and embed this. 4 - To maintain the Platinum School Games Mark We have begun work to maintain our Platinum School Games mark. 5 - Y6 Swimming This year, we will be providing catch up swimming lessons for children in year 5 and 6 who are not yet able to swim 25m. Additionally, all year 4 children will be undertaking swimming lessons in the summer term. Impact of Dedicated Coach £17075 - Continuing to have a qualified teacher as our sports coach is having an ongoing impact on participation rates in sporting activities. Furthermore, the coach works alongside teachers in PE lessons providing exceptional levels of CPD. Impact of NFSSP membership £1895 - access to the competition and festival schedule has been imperative to supporting us in achieving both gold and platinum. Access to advice and support from the SGO has been exceptional. We have also accessed free CDP training as part of this package. In addition to this funding we confinue to demonstrate our commitment to the legacy of sport and ensure sustainability by funding our own outdoor gym equipment with the support of our PTA. Grand opening in September 2021.
