Dear Parent/Guardian,

Year 5 + 6 residential visit – Little Canada

We are very excited to be able to announce that a four day residential visit to [Little Canada](#), a PGL centre on the Isle of Wight, has been booked for **Friday 17th June 2022 to Monday 20th June 2022**. Once again this year, the trip will be on a weekend following on from a normal 4 day week in school. Therefore it has been decided that parents/guardians will be able to choose whether to send their children to school on Tuesday 21st June. Due to the cancellation of last years' trip, this will be for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils.

The trip is a once in a lifetime opportunity, giving pupils the chance to live with their peers, develop independence and take greater responsibility. More importantly, they will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of exhilarating activities that provide challenge and adventure in a safe situation. In the past, pupils have experienced adventurous activities such as kayaking, abseiling, the trapeze, giant swing and many more.

The children will be under the guidance of fully qualified instructors all week who will ensure that all children have a memorable experience. Pupils will be accompanied by at least one member of the teaching staff and other members. In previous years we have asked for additional parent volunteers. Therefore, if you are interested please contact your child's class teacher.

We are aware that at this point in the year, many of you have questions and would like more information about the trip, therefore, an information presentation with details will be emailed to you the week commencing 29th November. This will give parents and children a chance to hear more about the trip and be informed of the Covid risk assessment. Also attached to this email, will be a Google Form allowing you to submit any questions you may have.

School visits are always a fantastic time for both children and adults alike and it is wonderful to see the children grow in self-confidence and rise to personal challenges in a non-academic environment. We are very much looking forward to taking all of the Upper Junior pupils on this exciting residential visit.
