4. Review and improve existing road markings.
5. Hampshire Police & New Forest District Council to carry out spot checks/ticketing.
6. Increase signage outside school.
7. Introduction of Parkwise to current and future pupils.
8. Introduction of safe walking routes to school.
9. Survey to establish current routines of travel to school.
10. Hampshire Police to attend June Team Hordle Assembly.
11. STP Team to update parents during review process.
12. Restore much needed faith with local residents.
13. Education regarding the health benefits of walking to school.
14. Ongoing monitoring of all aspects of the STP.
