My child is in Ladybirds and Bumblebees, when will I/we able to view my child's school report?

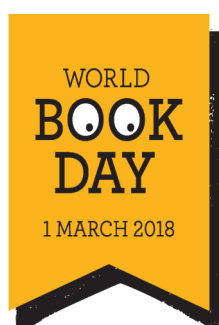
Children in the Ladybirds and Bumblebees do not use this system until the end of the year and will be provided with paper copies of the report.
