

SUNDAY SERVICES

On Sunday, at both churches, we try to offer both contemporary and traditional styles of worship so there should be a time and a style to suit everyone.

ALL SAINTS' CHURCH, HORDLE

9.15 am Morning Prayer on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays in the month and Holy Communion on the 2nd and 4th Sundays. A quieter, contemplative, more traditional service.

10.15 am A more lively, contemporary family service with modern songs. There are groups for children of 3 to 14, every Sunday in term time. Worship is led by a music group. The third Sunday in the month is Family Communion. On 4th Sundays there may be Baptisms at the service.

6.30 pm Holy Communion on the 1st Sunday in the month. On the 4th Sunday, we hold an informal, more laid-back service, which meets in the church hall, with music led by the worship group. On 5th Sunday, a Songs of Praise/Mission Service, alternating between All Saints and St. Andrew's.

ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH, TIPTOE

10.00 am Family Services the 2nd and 4th Sundays in the month (with groups for children in the Hall) and with Holy Communion on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays in the month.

6.30 pm on 5th Sunday: Songs of Praise/Mission Service, alternating between All Saints and St. Andrew's.

CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

Crèche – we have crèche facilities for children under 3yrs during the 10am services at both churches.

Sunday Club at All Saints' Hordle – during our 10.15am service we have Sunday Clubs in the hall for children aged 3 – 14 yrs.

Sunday Club at St. Andrew's Tiptoe – during our 10.00 am family services on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month, we have Sunday Clubs in the hall for children aged 3 – 11 yrs.

Friday Night Chill – club for children in school years 3 – 6. Meets in the Church Hall every Friday (during term time) from 5pm - 6.30pm - Wii, table tennis, pool, tuck shop, challenges, and lots of fun - £1 each per week.

Little Angels – our toddler group takes place in the church hall every Tuesday from 9.30 - 11.30am and 13.15 - 15.15pm.

Coffee pot — Every Friday at 8.30pm -10pm during term time. A drink, a biscuit, and a chat for Parents and carers of children from the school.
