Forty five Year 5 children took part in the annual Bikeability training scheme in May. The Scheme aims to gives children practical skills and understanding about how to

cycle on today's roads. Bikeability is the only government-recognised cycle training scheme, underpinned by national standards. Cycle training providers delivering Bikeability must use professional National Standard Instructors and operate within a quality assurance system. Bikeability is therefore a quality mark for cycle training, identifying cycle training delivered to the highest standards.
