Is your child interested in learning to play a brass instrument?

We are hoping to grow the school brass group! I teach Friday afternoons, which makes a noisy and fun way to end the week. At the moment I teach individual lessons but can start a beginning group if there is interest. Rates depend on class size and length of lesson (20-30 minutes) but are comparable with other music tuition.

I am an experienced and enthusiastic local brass musician and teacher. I work as a peripatetic and private brass teacher and teach individual and group lessons on trumpet, cornet, horn and low brass and run brass ensembles and bands. My pupils play in local youth bands and orchestras, participate in music festivals and take graded music exams. I have taught at Hordle School for 6 years.

Scientific research has shown that learning to play a musical instrument is a great benefit to the educational development of a child. It is proven that young musicians perform well in other academic subjects as the result of the discipline and concentration needed to learn an instrument. In addition, playing an orchestral instrument, such as a brass instrument, brings camaraderie and joy from making music in a group. My job is to introduce, teach and encourage children about the experience, fun and joy of brass music making.
