



## Hordle Primary School Clarinet Lessons

Teacher – Mrs L Tubb

If you would like your child to begin learning the clarinet you will need to purchase or hire an instrument. There are many suitable student models that can be found on the internet – ‘www.johnpacker.co.uk’ is a good site. The JPO21 model a good basic instrument, or ‘Dawkes’ supply the more expensive but robust Buffet B12 or Prodigy. They will also need a pack of Classic Vandoren Bb clarinet reeds strength 1 1/2. Pupils will require ‘A new tune a day: clarinet - book 1’ (with CD) ‘Abracadabra for the Clarinet’ or similar tutor book of choice.

Pupils will be required to practice regularly at home (short daily practices are best). Once confident in the basics, they will be invited to join the school Band.

Lesson times vary and can be discussed to find a mutually suitable time, before, during or after school. If more convenient, I also teach lessons at my house, a 5 minute walk from school in Woodcock Lane. If preferred, these can be 30-minute long. (£15)

Cost of 20-minute weekly lessons: **£10 for individual tuition**

- *Termly fees are payable by the first lesson of each term. Invoices will be sent out prior to this date.*
- *Termly fees are not refundable*
- *Fees for lessons missed through pupil’s absence from school are not refundable.*
- *Lessons missed through absence of the teacher will be re-arranged.*
- *Lessons missed because of pupil’s participation in a curriculum related activity will be re-arranged, if I have been notified in advance.*
