This hub is open to all pupils learning musical instruments and able to read basic music notation.

Members will need to be fairly confident at playing a range of notes and reading music notation, usually having had tuition for at least 1 term. Although drum kit and keyboard parts are restricted to a few players, pupils who receive lessons on these instruments will also have the opportunity to play tuned and un-tuned percussion.

Playing music in a group not only enhances musicality, but develops a high degree of self-discipline and confidence.

Pieces will be chosen to suit member's skills and sheet music will be available for practice at home and with instrumental teachers. Rehearsals are led in a relaxed style with the focus on enjoyment, so pupils should not worry about playing wrong notes (although we hope to get things right by performances!)

Cost of this hub also includes preparation of sheet music to suit individual needs, performances in the school and community as well as extra rehearsals in school time with individuals/groups when necessary.

Pupils who join the Band usually continue membership throughout the year, however, if your son/daughter decides to stop playing in the Band, if possible, please inform me before the start of the next Term, as renewal Membership forms will be sent home during the last week of each term.

- **Termly Fee = £15**
- Termly fees are payable by the first session of each term.
- Termly fees are not refundable
- Fees for lessons missed through a pupil's absence from school are not refundable.
- Rehearsals missed through absence of the teacher will be re-arranged in school time.
