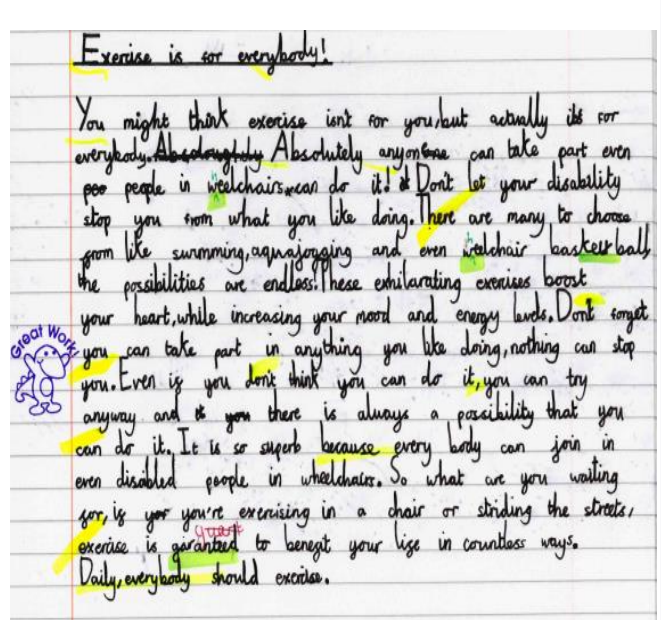


Maths

We read the book 'The Lion's Share' and then used drawings to solve a fraction problem.



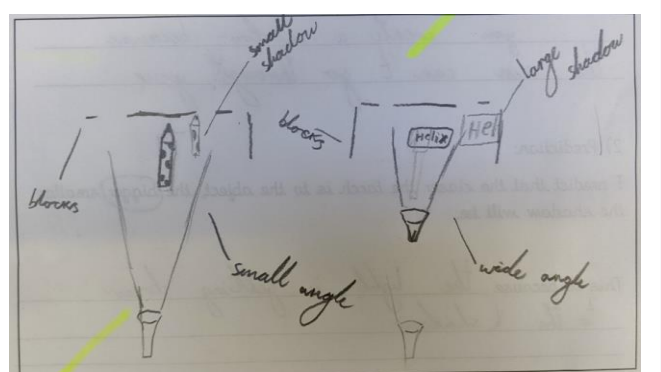
