Facts/Understanding the World

Pirates were people who sailed ships around the world looking for other ships to attack. When they attacked ships, they would try to steal whatever the other ship had, especially treasure.

Pirate ships flew a flag called the Jolly Roger.

Pirates had special words for lots of different things such as landlubbers (non-pirates), doubloons (gold coins) and booty (treasure). They often spoke with a growl and emphasised the 'r' sound.
