Year 5 visit to PGL Little Canada- 7th-10th June 2024

Where and When?

We are very excited to announce that a three night weekend residential visit to [Little Canada](#), PGL centre on the Isle of Wight has been booked for all year 5 for **Friday 7th June 2024 to Monday 10th June 2024**. Similar to last year, this trip will be on a weekend following on from a normal 4 day week in school and parents/guardians will be able to choose whether they prefer not to send children straight back to school on Tuesday 11th June 2024 which would be confirmed as authorised absence.

Why?

The trip is a once in a lifetime opportunity, giving pupils the experience of staying overnight with their peers, developing independence and taking on greater responsibility. More importantly, they will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of exhilarating activities that provide challenge and adventure in a safe situation. In the past, pupils have experienced adventurous activities such as kayaking, abseiling, the trapeze, giant swing and many more fun activities.

For the duration of their stay, the children will be under the guidance of fully qualified instructors who will ensure that they all have a memorable experience. The pupils will be accompanied by teachers and other members of staff. In previous years, we have asked for additional parent volunteers and will let you know at a later date should we require any additional parental support this year.

We are aware that many of you have questions and would like more information about the trip, therefore, an information presentation with more detail will be shared with you in the near future. This will give parents and children a chance to learn more about the trip closer to the time. Attached to this email, will be a **Google Form** to confirm your child's attendance.

School visits are always a fantastic time for both children and adults alike and it is wonderful to see the children grow in self-confidence and rise to personal challenges in a non-academic environment. We are very much looking forward to taking all the year 5 pupils on this exciting residential visit.
