Road Closure – Everton Road, Lymington Essential gas main replacement

From **Monday 15 January for approximately 12 Weeks**, our specialist contractors I&G Contractors LTD will commence a programme of work to replace the gas main along Everton Road in Lymington. We'll be replacing the gas man between house number 215 and the Manor House.

This work is essential to address the ongoing issue with leaks on this section of old gas main. Our engineers are unable to continue to repair the existing main, replacement is the only permanent solution.

We'll be replacing old metal gas pipes with a new plastic pipe to ensure we can continue to provide a safe and efficient gas supply to residents and wider community.

Due to the location of the gas main in the road and for everyone's safety, we have no other option than close the road to through vehicle traffic for the duration of the work. A signed diversion route will be in place for road users.

The following outlines key information you may find helpful.

- No through vehicle access past closure on Everton Road between 215 and the Manor House. Road users will need to use diversion routes
- Resident vehicle access to properties within the closure will be maintained, our team will liaise directly with residents to keep them informed of access arrangements.
- Pedestrian and Cycle access will be maintained for the duration of the closure.
- **Bus routes affected**, we'd advise passengers to contact their service providers for the latest update on changes to routes, timetables, and bus stop locations.
- **Bin collection/services** there will be no change to your regular collection days unless otherwise advised by your service provider.

We appreciate our work can be disruptive for residents and local community, we'd like to thank you for your patience and apologise in advance for the inconvenience we cause.
