Expert Vocabulary

mammals	Animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on the mother's milk as a baby.
bird	Animals that have two legs, wings and feathers.
fish	Animals that live and breathe under water. They have scaly skins, fins and breathe through gills.
reptile	Animals that have scales on their skin and breathe air.
amphibians	Animals that live in water as babies and on land as adults. They have scales on their skin.
carnivore	An animal that eats other animals.
herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
omnivore	An animal that eats plants and animals.
adult	A fully grown animal or plant
offspring	The child of an animal
young	Offspring that has not reached adulthood.
live young	Offspring that has not hatched from an egg.

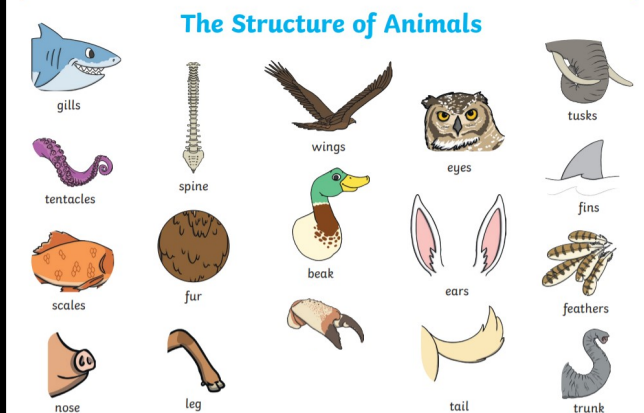
