## Scopay balances

### Dinners, clubs, Den and trips up to 31st March

As the financial year end for school draws to a close (31st March) it is very important that Breakfast and After School Club payments are up to date (**for bookings up to and including 31st March**) and that dinner money accounts remain in credit. However, please can we request where possible that you do not make payment for Den bookings taking place after 1st April.

Please check your child's balances on Scopay and update accordingly. If you are unsure, weekly reminders will be sent throughout March, please action when requested to do so.

If you are yet to pay an outstanding balance for any of the trips, including payment for PGL, please do so as a matter of urgency.

May we ask parents to communicate all changes to pick up from School, Hordle Hub Club or Den **by 2pm** so there is enough time to communicate these to the relevant teams across the school.

## Late school pick up

We continue to see an increase in late collections from school which are becoming increasingly tricky to manage as staff run clubs and attend meetings straight after school. If your child is collected late they will be taken to the Den.

Late collections are charged at £2.50 per 15 minutes and start at 3:30pm unless there are exceptional circumstances. Parents will be notified in writing and advised when the late charges have been applied and asked to make a payment via late collections on Scopay.
