Human Geography- Energy & Sustainability

Earth & Space (Science)


In this physics unit, children learn about how ideas around our solar system have developed through time to a heliocentric model. Furthermore, children will be working scientifically by comparing day and night by investigating sundials and how shadows help us to tell the time.

<u>English</u>

Holes Children will study chapters of this popular text in detail and write their own exciting 'escape' narrative using characters from the book. Balanced arguments Children use their knowledge from geography to debate and consider environmental issues.

A Christmas Carol Children study this festive classic by exploring the viewpoint of Ebenezer Scrooge.





<u>Maths</u>

- Identify and convert between equivalent fractions, including improper fractions and mixed numbers.
- Solve fractions problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Develop understanding of decimals, involving the 4 operations and rounding.
- Find percentages of amounts.







Supporting your child at home

Reading - we ask that children read 4x per week and that this is recorded in their reading challenge. Reading challenges are expected to be in school every day.

Homework - Maths or SPAG homework is set and checked each Wednesday. Please check Century for due assignments.

Spellings - We really appreciate your support in helping your child to learn their weekly spellings. They will be tested each Friday.

TTRS - Regular times table practise helps with many areas of the Upper Junior maths curriculum. We encourage children to complete 10 garage sessions per week.

If a child is unable to complete homework tasks at home, they will be invited to a lunch time catch up club.
